Attention Exhibitors

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for bitches in season. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, No refund of entry fee may be made. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Show. The judging will start promptly. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. **LOSS OR DAMAGE:** The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Event. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the Show. All rights to televise, video tape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the show grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph televise, video tape, audio tape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Kennel Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show. Their shall be no benching, nor offering for sale or breeding dogs.

Driving Directions

From North or South End

Take I-5, I-405, SR-167 to Highway 18 eastbound. Exit onto Auburn-Black Diamond Road eastbound. Turn RIGHT onto SE Green Valley Road (just past Neely mansion). Follow for about 7.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto 212th Way SE. Take First LEFT into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

From HWY 410 or WA 164 (Auburn-Enumclaw Hwy)

Turn LEFT onto 244th Ave. SE (approximately one mile out of Buckley) Go STRAIGHT at light on SE 436th Way/ WA - 164. Go STRAIGHT at stop sign SE 416th St. Go Straight at stop sign SE 400th St. Turn LEFT at stop sign onto SE 384th St. Turn RIGHT at stop sign 212 WAY SE. Turn RIGHT at ARGUS RANCH Sign (Just before Bridge). Follow drive STRAIGHT ahead to Arena and signed parking.

From SR 169 Southbound

Right onto Roberts Drive (in front of the Coal Car), go approximately four miles. Left onto 218th Street. At bottom of the hill is a stop sign. Go Straight across over cement bridge (Whitney Bridge). Take First Left into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

From SR 169 Northbound

Turn LEFT onto SE Green Valley Road (in front of the Boondocks Nursery). Go about four miles. Turn Left onto 212th Way SE. Go over the Cement Bridge. (Whitney Bridge). Take first LEFT into Argus Ranch and follow drive straight ahead to Arena and signed parking.

CRATE IDENTIFICATION TAGS

The welfare and safety of dogs is a critical issue at all events. The need for notification of owners is sometimes necessary, and critical time can be lost if this information is not readily available.

Please place a tag on EACH crate which contains the dog's call name, owner's name and/or name of responsible person at show, phone numbers and any special comments or conditions.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Animals left in vehicles will be monitored by County Control Officers and Club Members. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered and the owner cited.

PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE NO ELECTRICITY AVAILABLE AT THESE SHOWS

With the exception of paid overnight parking spaces, there will be no electricity available at these shows. To accommodate exhibitors who wish to use their own portable power generators for grooming, there will be a first come, first served grooming area designated for this purpose (generators may not be used outside of the designated grooming area). This grooming area will be within walking distance of the rings, but will not be directly on the field where the show rings and main grooming areas are located in respect of fellow exhibitors. Please help protect the future use of our beautiful show grounds. **Bring your own shade. Canopies for shade** are allowed at least 10 (ten) feet from any show ring as long as they do not obstruct the view of spectators and exhibitors and do not block the entrance to the ring. **No individual setup at ringside is allowed before 5:00 p.m. on Thursday.**
